Youth Development Phase Coach

Successful applicants will assist in the delivery of The Four Corner Development Model and Games Programme for players in the Youth Development Phase (YDP).

Applicants must:

- Be experienced in working with players in the Youth Development Phase
- Hold the UEFA B Coaching Licence
- Hold the FA Youth Module Award
- Have an in-date Safeguarding qualification
- Have an in date EFAiF (1st Aid in Football) qualification
- Be available Monday, Wednesday and Friday evenings, and Sundays for match days
- Undertake any training relevant to the post, including ongoing CPD training
- Be familiar with the PMA and willing to input the relevant information for training and games programme

Applicants must have:

- Previous professional academy coaching experience
- A meticulous attention to detail
- Good interpersonal skills – must be a consistent team performer
- Ability to prioritise workload
- Player recruitment experience
- Ability to travel independently
- Excellent IT Skills

- Excellent organisational qualities
- Ability to work to tight deadlines

Successful applicants will need to:

- Organise and lead YDP coaching sessions
- Collaborate with the Head of Coaching and Lead YDP Coach to ensure sessions are delivered to the academy coaching and playing philosophy
- Deliver match days to suit the club's playing philosophy and player development strategy
- Work with the academy multi-disciplinary team to ensure each individual player is maximising their potential

It is necessary to undertake any training relevant to the post, including ongoing CPD training, be trustworthy and adhere to codes of conduct, ethics and confidentiality.

The nature of the business means that there are significant variations in the level of activity; this requires the job holder to work whatever hours are needed to allow deadlines to be met.

The position is subject to a DBS at Enhanced Level, references and a six-month probationary period.

Specific Responsibilities:

- In conjunction with the Head of Coaching (HOC) and Lead YDP Coach oversee and deliver the technical programme for academy players in the YDP
- Monitor the development of the players, recording individual player data on the PMA
- Liaise with the Head of Coaching and Lead YDP Coach to create session plans appropriate to individual learning
- Devise individual learning objectives and action plans for each player within the YDP
- In conjunction with the HOC, Lead YDP Coach and Head of Education formulate and deliver a review process every 6 weeks for each Academy player and provide written assessment player feedback bi-annually to the parents
- Liaise closely with the Head of Recruitment/AMT on identifying and monitoring trialist players for the YDP age groups
- Manage a YDP age group alongside HOC/Lead YDP Coach/part-time coaches in the category specific league, cup and friendly fixtures
- To coach and deliver from the Academy Performance Plan
- Ensure that players graduating in the YDP do so with a high degree of technical and tactical ability with physical, psychological and social capability.
- Specialist trained to ensure that players graduating from the phase have built upon the core ball mastery skills and are able to apply individual skills

appropriately in a team setting, with a growing tactical awareness of their role in the team

- Maintain a weekly training report for the Head of Academy/HOC
- Deliver group and individual weekly performance objectives
- Assist in the evaluation of the weekly performance objectives
- Assist in the monitoring of performance, reporting and evaluating the players in the YDP
- Assist in the monitoring and supervision of physical development
- Take part in all relevant meetings including in service training, parent meeting's/reviews at the request of the manager
- Show a continuous commitment to personal development through CPD and relevant courses
- Be aware of the clubs Coaches Code of Conduct, Child Protection policy, Health & Safety policy and Emergency procedures
- Take responsibility for the safety of those participating or under your guidance
